Listed below is information about how Northern District will handle District Youth Art, Youth Art Challenge, Mississippi Crafts and Member Photography Contest for 2021.

## Youth Art and Youth Art Challenge

To submit an entry for judging at District Level

1. The teacher (private or schoolteacher) or club member sponsoring students receiving no art instruction must take a front-view picture of the artwork and complete a typewritten identification card for each picture. Identification cards can be found on our website. [Click here](#) for Youth Art Contest Identification Card or [Click here](#) for Youth Art Challenge Contest Identification Card.
2. Picture and Identification card must be emailed to District President Lisa McGee at [lm.barefield@gmail.com](mailto:lm.barefield@gmail.com) before 11:59 p.m. on Wednesday, March 3, 2021. Pictures that are mailed will not be accepted.
3. All work must be original and done with the last 12 months. Items previously entered in MFWC contest are ineligible.
4. Each club may submit two entries in each of the five division of the three classes.

- Photographs must be taken between January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2020, providing a special allowance for two years of photographs for the 2021 contests, since the 2020 Photography Contests were not held.

For District Photography Winners:

- First Place winners will be notified and will need to mail their mounted entries to State Photography Chairman Dawn Vosbein in order to be judged at State Level.

- See the GFWC Photography Contest guide for a complete set of rules on the GFWC Portal. Please verify that you have followed all rules for the contest. Entries that do not follow the contest rules will be disqualified. You may want to pay close attention to the thickness of your mounting board.
